



Packing List for International Students

Important Documents:

- **Passport (with student visa)**
- **Admission letter from the university**
- **Confirmation of Enrollment (CoE)**
- **Copies of academic transcripts and certificates**
- **Financial proof documents (bank statements, scholarship letters)**
- **Health and immunization records**
- **Travel insurance documents**
- **Emergency contact information**
- **Copies of important documents (keep both physical and digital copies)**

Clothing:

- **Seasonal clothing (summer and winter attire)**
- **Casual clothes for everyday wear**
- **Formal wear for university events or job interviews**
- **Sportswear and swimwear**
- **Comfortable shoes (sneakers, sandals, formal shoes)**
- **Raincoat or umbrella**
- **Accessories (hats, scarves, gloves)**

Electronics:

- **Laptop and charger**
- **Mobile phone and charger**
- **Plug adapters (Australia uses Type I plug)**

- Headphones or earphones
- Portable hard drive or USB sticks
- Power bank
- Camera (optional)

Personal Items:

- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant)
- Skincare products
- Prescription medications (with prescriptions)
- First-aid kit (band-aids, pain relievers, antiseptic wipes)
- Personal hygiene products
- Glasses or contact lenses (with prescription)
- Towel and washcloth

Study Supplies:

- Notebooks and pens
- Planner or organizer
- Backpack or tote bag
- Calculator (if required for your course)
- Binders or folders
- Sticky notes and highlighters

Kitchen Essentials:

- Basic utensils (fork, knife, spoon)
- Reusable water bottle
- Lunch box or food container
- Travel mug or coffee cup
- Non-perishable snacks for the journey

Miscellaneous:

- Bedding (sheets, pillowcases, blanket, pillow)
- Laundry bag and detergent
- Small sewing kit

- Reusable shopping bags
- Basic toolkit (screwdriver, pliers)
- Travel pillow and eye mask for the journey
- Cultural items (small decorations or souvenirs from home)

Financial Essentials:

- Local currency (Australian dollars) for initial expenses
- Credit/debit cards
- Bank account details (if already set up)

Things to Arrange Before Departure:

- Accommodation arrangements (confirmation and address)
- Airport pickup service (if provided by the university)
- Join relevant social media groups or forums for incoming students
- Inform your bank about your move to avoid card blocks

Optional Items:

- Small gifts or souvenirs from Nigeria for new friends or hosts
- Favorite books or personal entertainment items
- Musical instrument (if you play one)
